

SteelMac Repair and Reinforce Bufadero Barracks After Storm

5th - 8th February 2010

After strong gusts of wind had severely damaged the 'Bufadero' Army Barracks near Europa Point, SteelMac Ltd was called in to secure the roof and repair any damages. The team was mobilised just two hours after getting the call and all the relevant assets were deployed on scene.

With safety a main concern, the roof was secured and the repairs were then carried out according to strict regulations. The SteelMac team were also using all necessary safety equipment as the position of the barracks exposes the roof to strong gusts of wind at any time. Using a Manitou 2150, as well as the SteelMac 'KATO city crane the project was completed over a three day period.
